AVERAGE REQUIREMENTS (Please read carefully.)

Entrants must use their highest USBC sanctioned league average whether bowled as a regular or substitute. Only averages established in **Nebraska** USBC leagues in will be accepted. Averages accepted in the following order:

- Final 2006-2007 regular season average of 21 games or more. Book average is considered official.
- If no 2006-07 average, use the December 31, 2007 average, with at least 21 games or more.
- If none of the above, use current average of 12 games or more on the day you bowl in the tournament
- If none of the above, use the final 2007 summer season average, 21 games or more.
- Bowlers who do not meet any of these requirements shall be automatically entered with a 220 average.
- Rules 319a(2), 319d and 319e are waived.

If an entrant is a member of another local association, the manager of that association must also verify average. Attach a separate sheet if necessary. (A complete copy of the rules will be included in the confirmation mailing.)

Termination/Release Clause: The entrants whose names appear hereon or their authorized replacements hereby agree the Nebraska USBC Association, Inc., its officers and agents shall be liable only to the extent of returning entry fees if and when these entrants shall be prevented from bowling any event in the tournament through premature termination of the tournament, which may be brought about by war, national emergency or emergencies or causes relating thereto or resulting therefrom, fires, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties or other causes beyond the control of the Nebraska USBC Association, Inc. Any erroneous averages, falsification of secretary's signatures, or infractions of tournament rules may cause disqualification of the team.

The weekends of March 8-9 and April 18-19-20 are "smoke-free" weekends. On those days, smoking will be allowed only in an enclosed bar area at the bowling center. Entrants are not allowed to smoke during competition.

Refunds: Entry fees will not be refunded except when Nebraska USBC notifies an entrant of dates and times assigned and a refusal has been received by Nebraska USBC within 10 days of the date of the notice.

Attire: Entrants are expected to wear suitable attire. Use good judgment when selecting the appropriate attire. Clothing with derogatory, offensive or suggestive language will not be permitted. Examples of prohibited attire include but are not limited to: hats (medical reasons only – request must be in writing), tank tops, halter tops, bare midriffs, spaghetti strap tops, short shorts, short skirts, jeans that are not neat, clean or in good condition. Bowlers will be required to change if attire is deemed inappropriate by tournament management or designee. Tournament management or designee decision will be final.

Groups: Groups of three or more teams wanting to be scheduled together may call for reserved space. These must be paid by October 15, 2007.

The Nebraska USBC Annual Meeting will be held In Grand Island on April 6, 2008.
